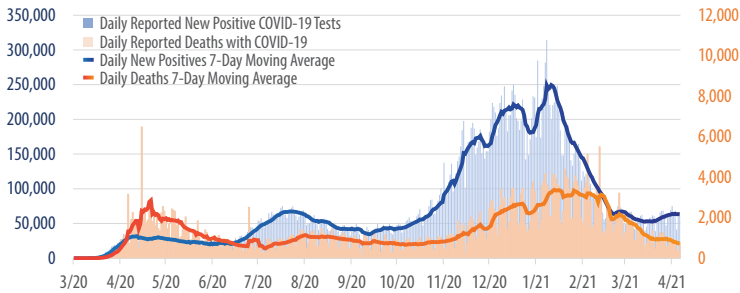

Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths with COVID-19 in the U.S.

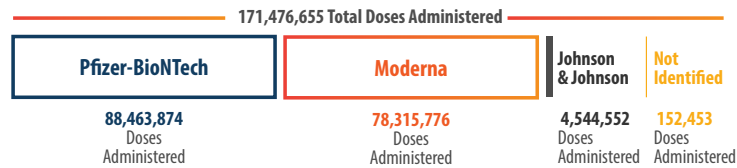

U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type

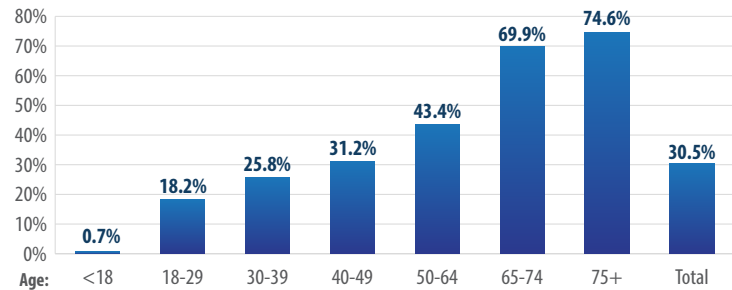

Share of People Who Have Received at Least One Dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine by Age

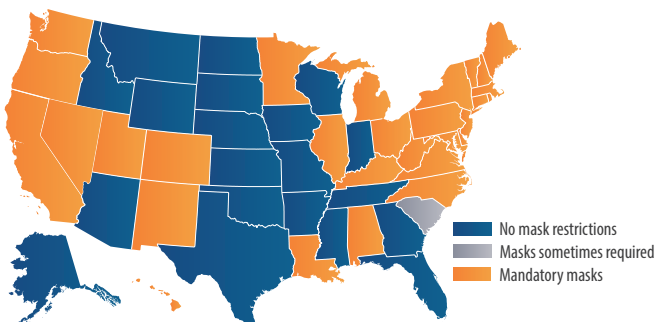

As of April 7, 2021

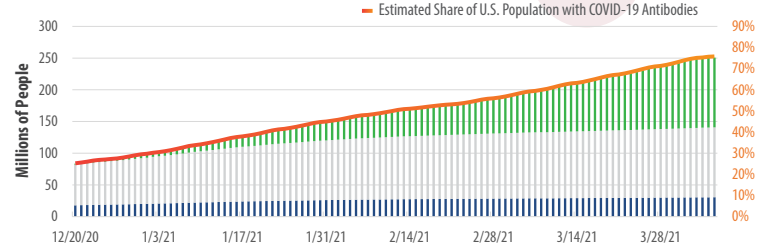

Path to Herd Immunity

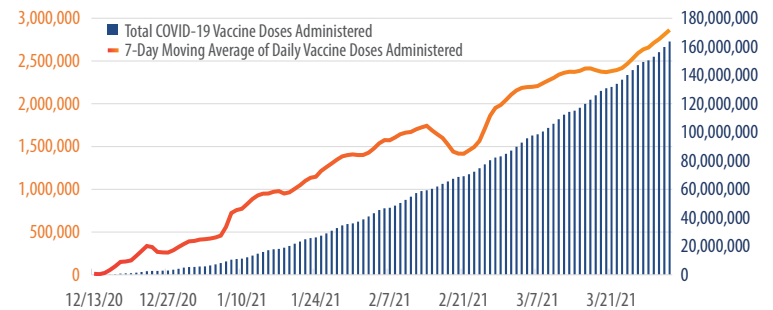

December 13, 2020 - April 1, 2021

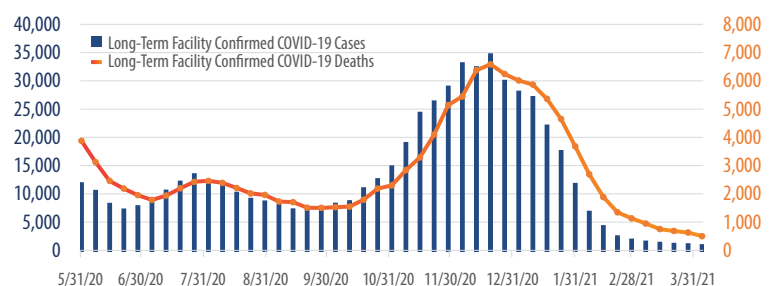
