

Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths with COVID-19 in the U.S.




#### **U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type**


## Share of People Who Have Received at Least One Dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine by Age





May 31, 2020 - March 7, 2021




Since their respective peaks, COVID-19 cases have plummeted 73%, COVID-19 deaths have declined by 54%, while COVID-19 hospitalizations are down 71%. Currently, COVID-19 patients occupy 12.2% of total ICU beds, while only 5.87% of total inpatient beds are being used.<sup>1</sup>
